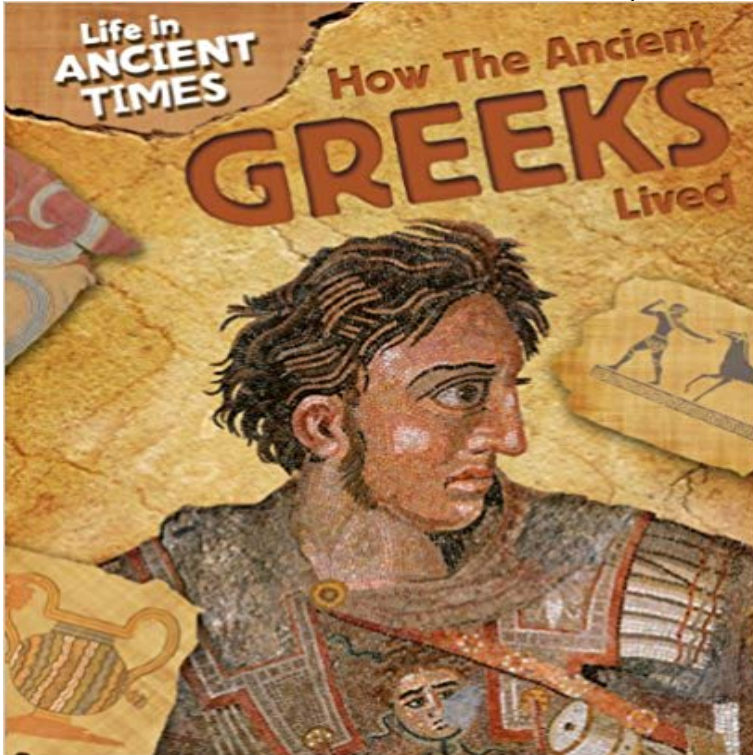


## How the Ancient Greeks Lived (Life in Ancient Times)

Una vez coronadas las cimas anteriores hay que continuar la travesía en dirección a la al Cantoblanco, que se asciende tras un durillo cortafuegos.
