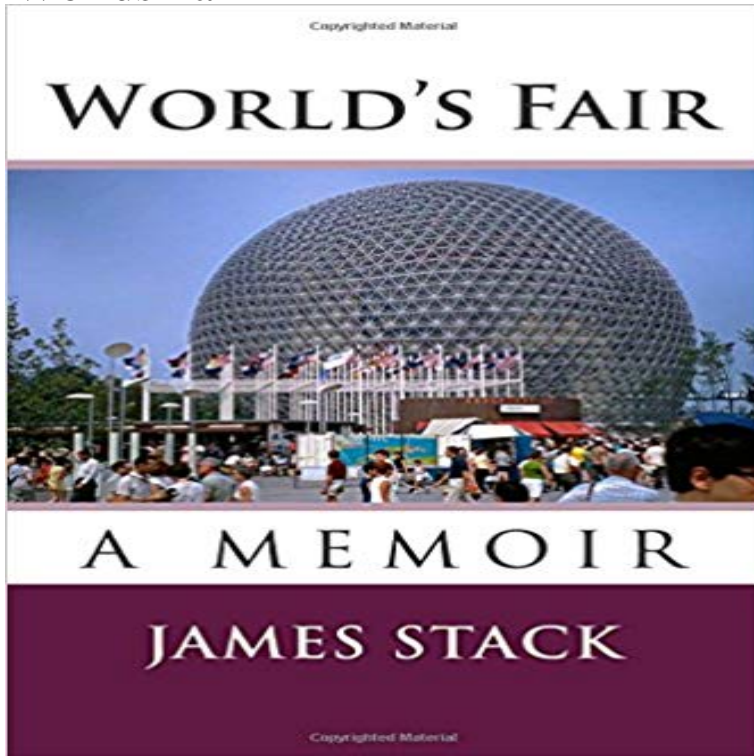


Worlds Fair



Told from the point of view of the author who was 15 at the time Worlds Fair is the raw and witty true story of a dysfunctional Southern familys harrowing motor-home road trip from South Carolina to the Montreal Worlds Fair in 1967 during The Summer of Love. An intimate coming-of-age story, Worlds Fair shines a bright light on the issues of alcoholism, adolescent sexual confusion, family violence and the universal need to love those who hurt us, despite their frailties.

Al Olvedo se llega relativamente rápido. A pesar de que las nubes a veces nos impiden apreciar las vistas, el paisaje se intuye precioso.

Para pasar del Olvedo al Pelistornes tan sólo tenemos que cruzar el collado y llegaremos en apenas 10 minutos a nuestra segunda cima del día.

Una vez coronadas las cimas anteriores hay que continuar la travesía en dirección a la al Cantoblanco, que se asciende tras un durillo cortafuegos.
