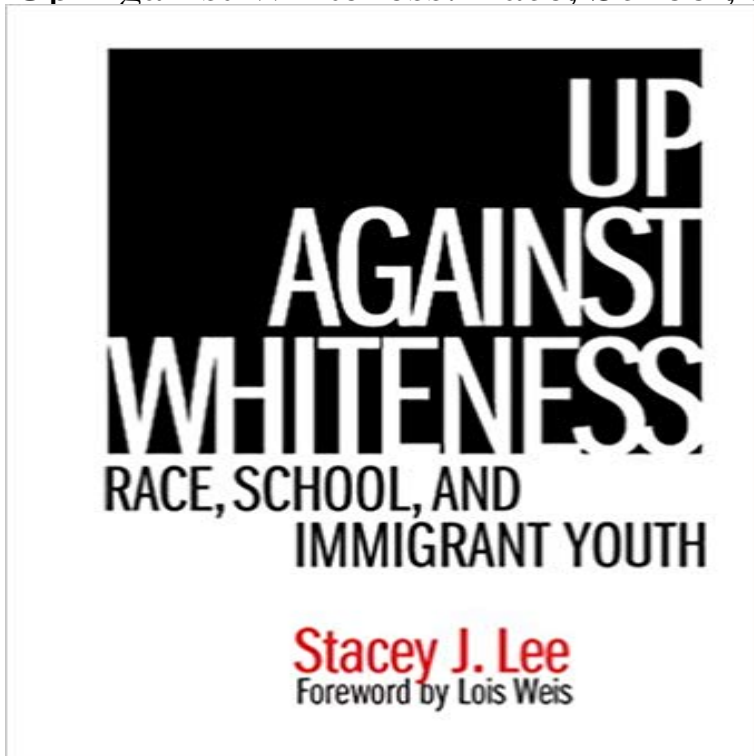


## Up Against Whiteness: Race, School, and Immigrant Youth
