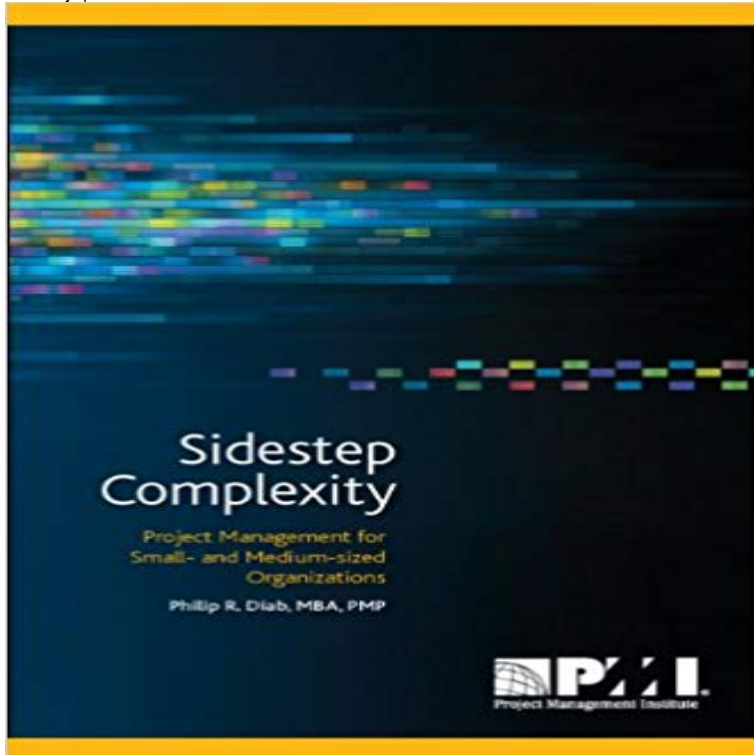


# Sidestep Complexity: Project Management for Small- and Medium-Sized Organizations
