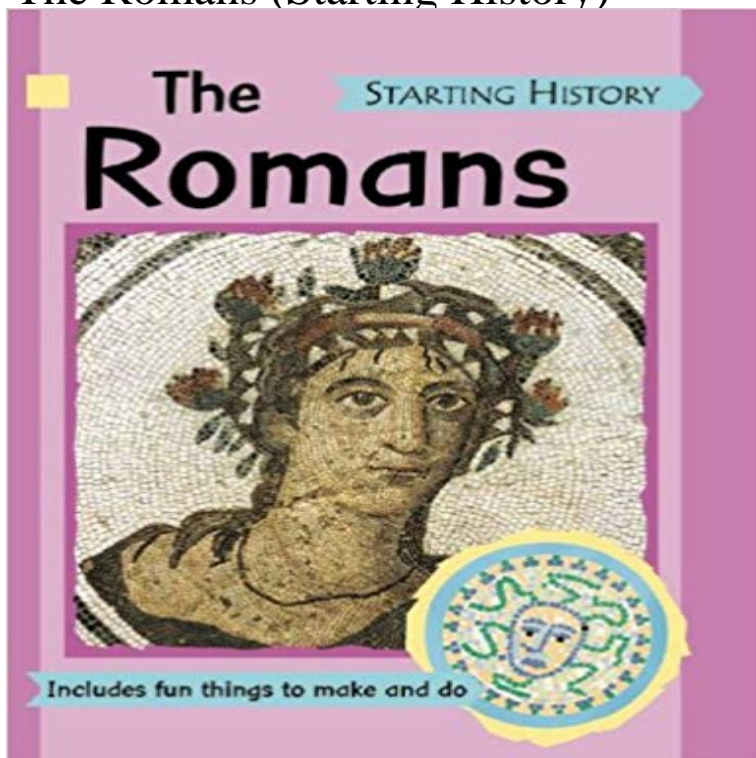


The Romans (Starting History)
