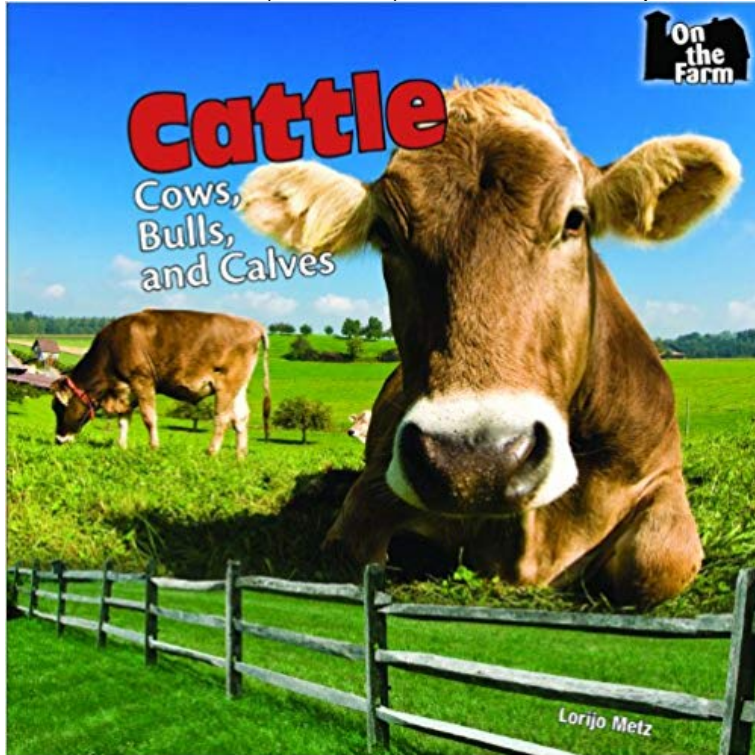


Cattle: Cows, Bulls, and Calves (On the Farm)
